

GRADING SYSTEM OF THE INSTITUTION

According to the

REGULATION about the assessment of students of academic and specialist graduate academic studies at the Polytechnic in Rijeka (adopted by The Academic Council of the Polytechnic in Rijeka at the 198th meeting held on 27th September 2019, on the basis of Article 44 of the Statute of the Polytechnic of Rijeka, Class: 003-05/15-01/07, Reg. Number: 2170-57-01-15-4 of 16th March 2015 (the full text of 31st October 2017).

The Polytechnic of Rijeka uses the ECTS grading scale.

Grading scale

Grading and evaluation of students' achievements upon completion of course:

Acquired level of learning outcomes (%)	Numerical system of grading	ECTS grades
90 to 100%	Excellent (5)	A
75 to 89.99%	Very good (4)	B
60 to 74.99%	Good (3)	C
50 to 59.99%	Sufficient (2)	D
0 to 49.99%	Insufficient (1)	F

- Passing grades are: excellent (5), very good (4), good (3) and sufficient (2).
- The numerical grade, ECTS grade and the percentage of knowledge skills and competences are recorded in the student's own course and assessment booklet.

Educator's duties

An educator is responsible, at the beginning of a semester, to familiarise students with the method of earning the final % grade during the classes and at the final exam of their course.

Exam taking times

The educator announces the schedule of exam's during the semester.

Overall success

Based on the average % of acquired learning outcomes at the end of the study, the final average of acquired learning outcomes of a student is demonstrated from all passed subjects via a unique comprehensive classification of qualification (classification of honours).

- First-Class Honours – 90-100% acquired knowledge, skills and competencies by the student during studies.
- Upper Second-Class Honours - 80-89.99% acquired learning outcomes by the student during studies.
- Lower Second-Class Honours - 70-79.99% acquired learning outcomes by the student during studies.

- Third-Class Honours – 60-59.99% acquired learning outcomes by the student during studies.
- Pass – 50-59.99% acquired learning outcomes by the student during studies.

Students with the greatest final average % of acquired learning outcomes at the end of the studies are assigned honours on a report or diploma from the Latin classification honours:

- Bachelor with the highest honours (SUMMA CUM LAUDE Baccalaureus), or a Specialist with highest honours (SUMMA CUM LAUDE Baccalaureus) with final attainment higher than 98 %.
- Bachelor with the highest honours (MAGNA CUM LAUDE Baccalaureus), or a Specialist with the highest honours (MAGNA CUM LAUDE Baccalaureus) with final attainment higher than 94 %.
- Bachelor with honours (CUM LAUDE Baccalaureus), or a Specialist with honours (CUM LAUDE or Specialist) with final attainment higher than 90 %.

The average % of the acquisition of learning outcomes is set in a way that the products of the multiplication % of acquired learning outcomes and ECTS points of each subject are added together and divided by the total number of ECTS points in the study (180 ECTS points in academic studies, or 120 points in specialist diploma academic studies).

Application of the Regulation

This Regulation comes into force on the eight day from the day of publication on the information board of the Polytechnic.

The Regulation will apply from academic year 2019-20.
